DATE: UPDATE SINCE LAST REPORT:	 25/06/2024 From March 2024 there was the start of an additional Youth Club session at The Depot. This has succeeded to split the age groups with the Tuesday session reduced to an hour and a half and aimed at Year 6 to Year 8. The attendance can be as many as 48 children or young people attending. An additional session being held on a Thursday, again for an hour and a half, whose focus is to attract 14+ group. Attendance between 3 and 9 young people. Condom distribution is available at this session and encouragement to order and take a STI test, for those sexually active. (A 16 year old YP was very reluctant for the postal STI test to come to their home). In consultation with Warwickshire County Council Bikability Level 2 and 3 courses will be running in the Summer holidays, from the Eric Payne Centre. Free for young people/residents. Alcester Town Council are
