UPDATE SINCE LAST REPORT:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Nine speed watch (CSW) sessions conducted in 2024 across Captains Hill, Kinwarton Farm Road, Stratford Road and Evesham Street.• New arrangements in place for sending data to Warwickshire Police.• New Bushell device purchased CSW sessions• Police liaison officer for Warwickshire attended January meeting.• Communications sent asking for additional CSW volunteers but no takers to date.• Resident Survey conducted with 101 responses received.• Ongoing discussions between Alcester Grammar School and local organisation regarding potential solution for student parking.• Ongoing discussions between the Working Group and St Nicholas Primary School regarding potential solutions to alleviate St Faiths Road traffic issues.• Vegetation interfering with road signage in Stratford Road reported to WCC.
