ATC Operations

 A large ash tree fell in Moorfields Park which blocked the rear entrance of Waitrose.
 We were grateful to Trees 'N' Gardens for dealing with this so promptly on 9th December. The tree was subject to a TPO and SDC have asked us to plant a replacement in due course.
 - We also lost two very large conifers in the old cemetery. The work to remove these is almost complete.
